The East African School of Aviation Wilson airport campus (EWAC) is the 1<sup>st</sup> satellite campus of the East African School of Aviation (EASA). The campus was opened in October 2015 and admitted the 1<sup>st</sup> group of students in March 2016. The campus was established in order to make EASA products accessible to the larger population. It also aims at expanding our programmes by introducing demand driven training programmes to the rapidly growing aviation industry especially at

Wilson Airport and its environs. EWAC offers both full time and evening programmes for aviation professionals as well as those aspiring to join the industry. The school has trained aviation professionals in areas of Flight Operations/Dispatch, Aviation security, Dangerous goods regulations, Airside Safety and Aircraft Loading and Handling. The school has attracted participants from Kenya, Uganda, South Sudan and Botswana.
