Job Purpose: To offer instructional services to students pursuing Travel & Tourism Management Training at EASA.

a) Job Specification

This is the entry and training grade for this cadre except for in-service courses where regulatory requirements apply. The officer will discharge their duties under the supervision of a senior officer. The Instructor role will involve the following:

- i. Interpreting and implementing training policies and regulations;
- ii. Carry out research on subject matter for continuous improvement and development of the courses;
- iii. Development and review of programmes and course materials;
- iv. Preparation of course plans, schemes of work and lesson plans;
- v. Training delivery in the area of specialization;
- vi. Ensure setting up of simulators, laboratories, workshops and classroom teaching aids;
- vii. Evaluating, assessing and examining trainees in compliance with relevant policies and guidelines, processing results;

- viii. Ensuring integrity, accuracy and security of academic records;
- ix. Ensuring training manuals, methods, teaching aids and processes are compliant to national and international regulations and standards;
- x. Any other duties allocated by the Chief Lecturer/Instructor.

- (vi) A Degree in Travel and Tourism Management will be an added advantage.
