Climate

There are four distinct seasons in Kenya



- Warm-dry season: From January to late March
- Long rainy season: Late March to early June
- Cool dry season: Mid-June to early October
- Short rainy season: Mid-October to Mid-December

Travel Information

To facilitate your way to Kenya, kindly ensure that you have;

1. Visa

While all travelers arriving in Kenya should have a valid Passport, Kenya entry visas are not required for nationals from some countries.

Those who are not exempted should apply for visas in advance from Kenya High Commissions or Embassies, which will be issued upon meeting the set requirements. For countries with no Kenya High Commission or Embassy, the British Embassy or High Commission will generally represent Kenya and be in a position to issue visas.

2. Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate (if applicable)

3. Personal travel/medical insurance to cover yourself for the training period in Kenya.

4. Valid passport with minimum 6 months validity at the time of departure.

Transport to/From EASA

No transport will be provided to and from the hotel. Participants are advised to arrange for their own transport during the course.

Modes of Transportation

Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) is situated 16 km from the City Centre. The bus fare from the Airport to the City Centre is around \$1. Taxis are readily available from the Airport to the City Centre at an estimate of \$20- \$30. However, it is advisable to confirm the charges before getting into the vehicle. Modes of payment

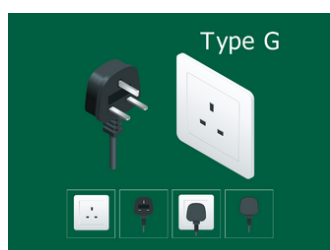
The basic unit of currency is the Kenyan shilling. There are silver and bronze coins of 1 shilling; bronze 5 shillings, 20 shillings and 40 shillings. Notes are issued in denominations of 50, 100, 200, 500 and 1000 shillings.

Arrival Passenger Guide

Upon arriving at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, there are airport signages to guide you through customs and immigration and to retrieve your baggage.

Money Changing Services

Commercial banks and Forex bureaux provide exchange facilities. If you need Kenyan currency immediately on arrival, the banks at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport are open daily from 7.00am to midnight. Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) that accept major credit cards such as Visa, MasterCard and American Express are conveniently located within the city.



Electricity

In Kenya the power plugs and wall sockets are of type G. The standard voltage is 240 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

Security

The security in Nairobi is good. However, as a matter of precaution, participants are advised not to take strolls out of the hotels on foot at night.

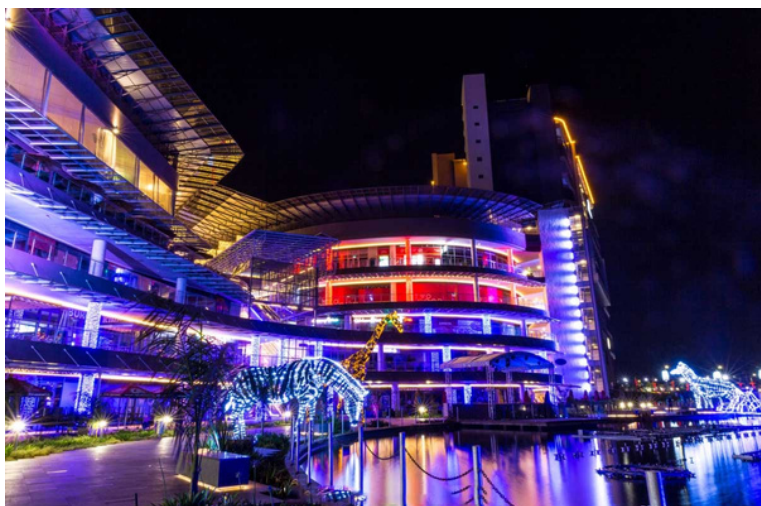
You can also find a collection of other creations from different tribes in Kenya including stone carvings from the Kisii and wood carvings from the Kamba.

Health

- EASA has a school nurse who will attend to your medical needs and advise in case you need to see a doctor.
- In the event of a medical emergency, Kenya has public and private hospitals which require upfront payment. All foreign delegates are required to come with medical insurance that have overseas coverage.
- Covid-19 health protocols are applicable as outlined below by the Ministry of Health.

The following measures shall apply to travelers departing and arriving into the country as at 09th May 2023.

1. All travelers arriving into the country through any point of entry shall no longer be required to show proof of either COVID-19 vaccination or a pre-departure COVID-19 test.
2. Only travelers arriving at any port of entry into Kenya with flu-like symptoms will be required to fill the passenger locator form on the 'jitenge' platform: https://ears.health.go.ke/airline_registration/. They will also be required to take a COVID-19 antigen test upon arrival at their own cost. Those who turn out positive for antigen test will be required to take a further COVID-19 PCR test at their own cost. Those with severe symptoms shall thereafter be allowed to isolate as per the prevailing isolation requirements for mild, moderate and severe disease.
3. Passengers traveling out of the country will be required to abide by the particular travel, health and COVID-19 related requirements of the transit and destination country.
4. Pre-departure RDT or PCR testing maybe considered at the discretion of any of the airlines departing from or terminating in Kenya.
